West Main Community Park - Master Plan

Batavia Park District, Kane County, Illinois

Working together makes better outdoor play.

Upland Design is assisting the Batavia Park District with its plans to expand recreational opportunities at West Main Community Park. The site includes 58-acres owned by the Park District as well as 20 acres owned by Kane County Forest Preserve District.

Input by Park District residents, sport affiliate groups, the School District and Park District staff played important roles in the master plan process. The final plan presented by Upland Design includes the needs of all groups while being sensitive to existing high quality trees.

Elements include:

- Interior multi-use trail system creating accessibility throughout the site.
- Trail links to the adjacent Dick Young Forest Preserve and Nelson Lake.
- Three new ball diamonds with lighting
- Multi-use sport field with potential uses of soccer, rugby and football
- Shade/picnic shelter
- Community sized playground
- Cross country course for high school use
- Concession and restroom building
- Maintenance facility location
- Expanded parking lots for new sports
- Landscaping to highlight views and buffer adjacent roadways
